**Will it build *Goodwill* and *Better Friendships*?**

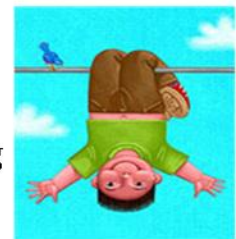
**Will it be *Beneficial* to all concerned?**
